EGU Training School

The main objective of the training school is to present and discuss the geoheritage management topic, namely the conservation, promotion and monitoring of geosites and geodiversity sites.

The understanding of these management actions and the learning from successful examples are essential tools in any geoconservation strategy and in the establishment of priorities in site management.

The training school is addressed to early career scientists (35 years old or younger) and undergraduate or postgraduate students (who obtained her/his highest degree qualification within the last two years) involved with any topic related to geoheritage and aiming to know more about these subjects.

It comprises 4 full days of lectures and discussion at the University of Minho and 1 day of fieldwork in a Portuguese UNESCO Global Geopark. The lecturers are internationally recognized experts on geoheritage and management.

EGU is sponsoring partially or totally the travel and accommodation expenses to facilitate the attendance of key young researchers.
EGU grants application is open until 28th February 2018.

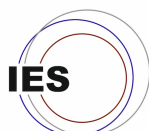
